Our processes and decisions

- Solid definition of properties, their boundaries and rights
- Strong protection of ownership and other rights to land
- Attractive, transparent market for investments in real property



Cadastral services

Make land available for housing and infrastructure investments

Meet changing needs

Cadastral surveyor investigates and balances interests



Land registration

Decide and collect stamp duty – 1 bn USD/year Close cooperation with financial sector simplifies procedures and improves lending process Register is complete, rights are guaranteed



Provision of property information

>1 mn enquiries/month

Information updated by Lantmäteriet, Tax administration and local government Unique national id and addresses for each property

Extensive updating of public and private systems, thereby ensuring data is correct and up-to-date



Provision of geographic information

Everything happens somewhere Basis for e-services and digitalization



E-government, digitalization and automated decision-making

- Assessment for Property Tax purposes
- Register of dwellings, population register, the census and more
- Election roll



Example – use of GNSS

- Road construction: Road administration + construction companies
- Agriculture: >20 USD/hectar + higher yields
- Sea transport: increased draught 10 cm => 130' USD/ship
- Cadastral procedures: >1 hr/matter
- Etcetera!
